Boyer Hall is the new centerpiece of Messiah College. This 180,000 square ft building houses the schools of humanities, science and technology. Classrooms and faculty offices are strategically placed in proximity to each other. The materials, finishes and fixtures were all selected by the Baltimore firm Metropolitan Studios. Substantially, all of the furnishings were provided by Environmental Interiors working closely with the manufacturers Lacasse and Falcon. In addition to furnishings, E.I. also worked closely with the general contractor Wholsen Construction to create a unique technology floor using Haworth Nexus flooring for the Language Lab area.
